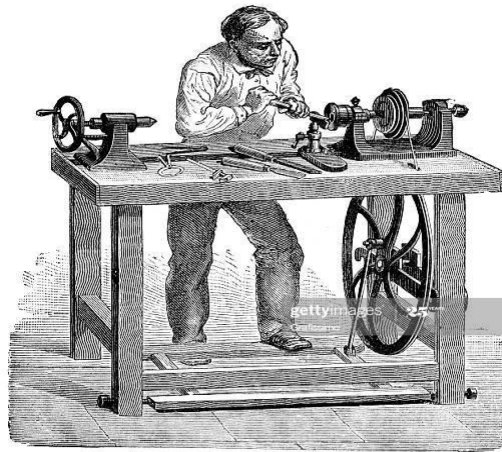
As you were aware, the metal detector is still missing, so we are having to buy a new one at a cost to the club for \$95.00 plus freight!! which will probably go under lock and key.

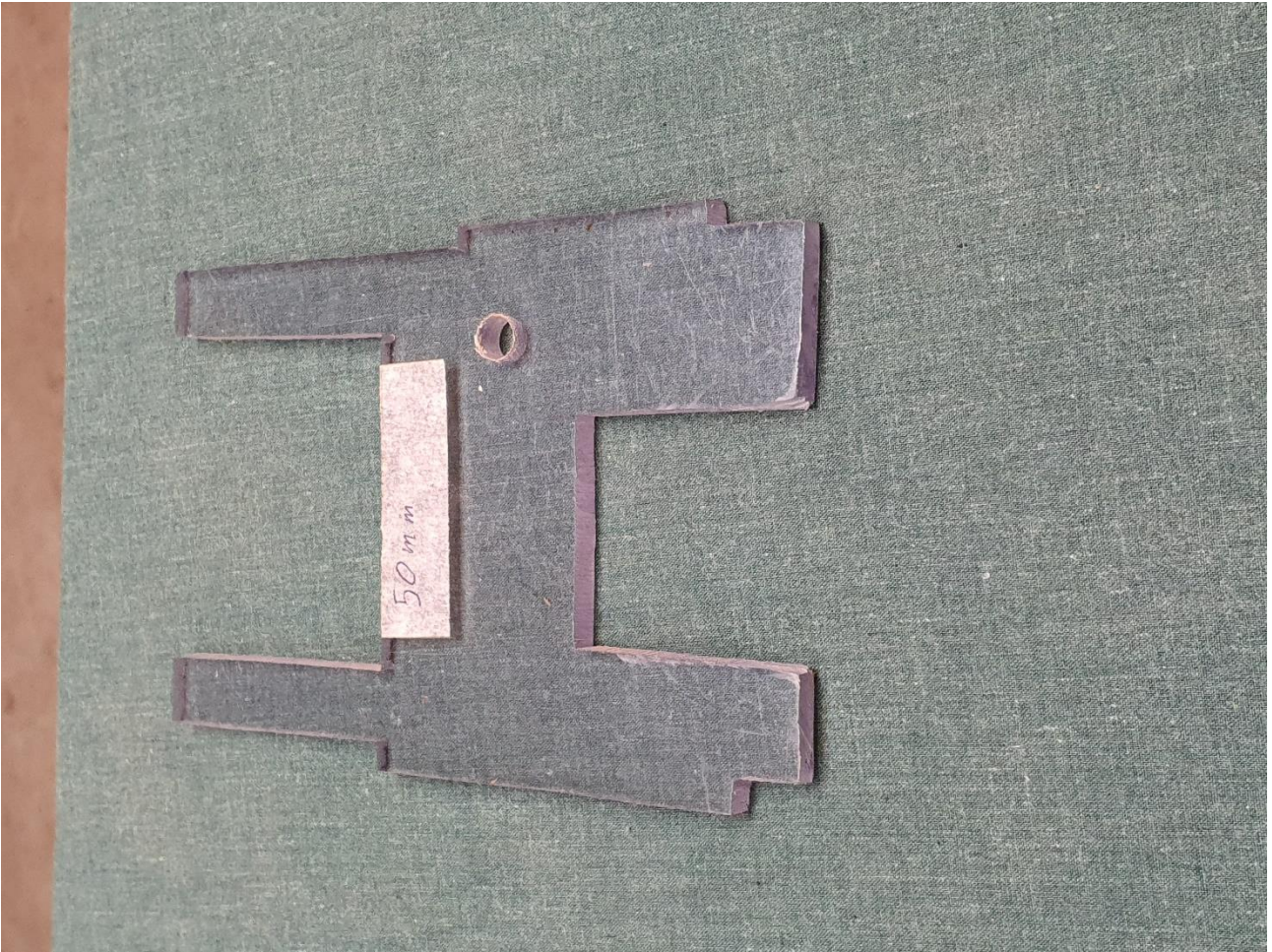
